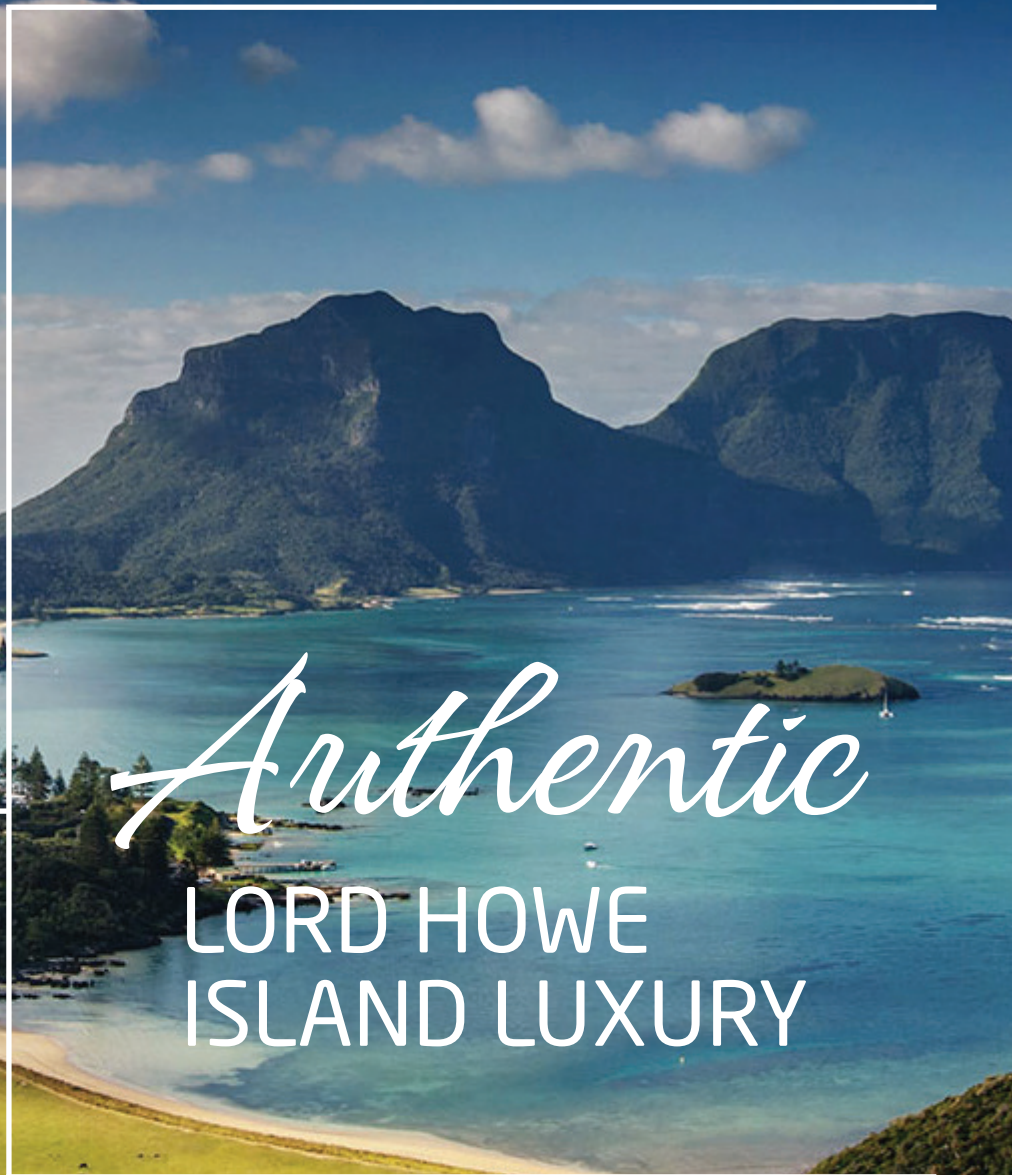

Time. Space. Stars. Sea.

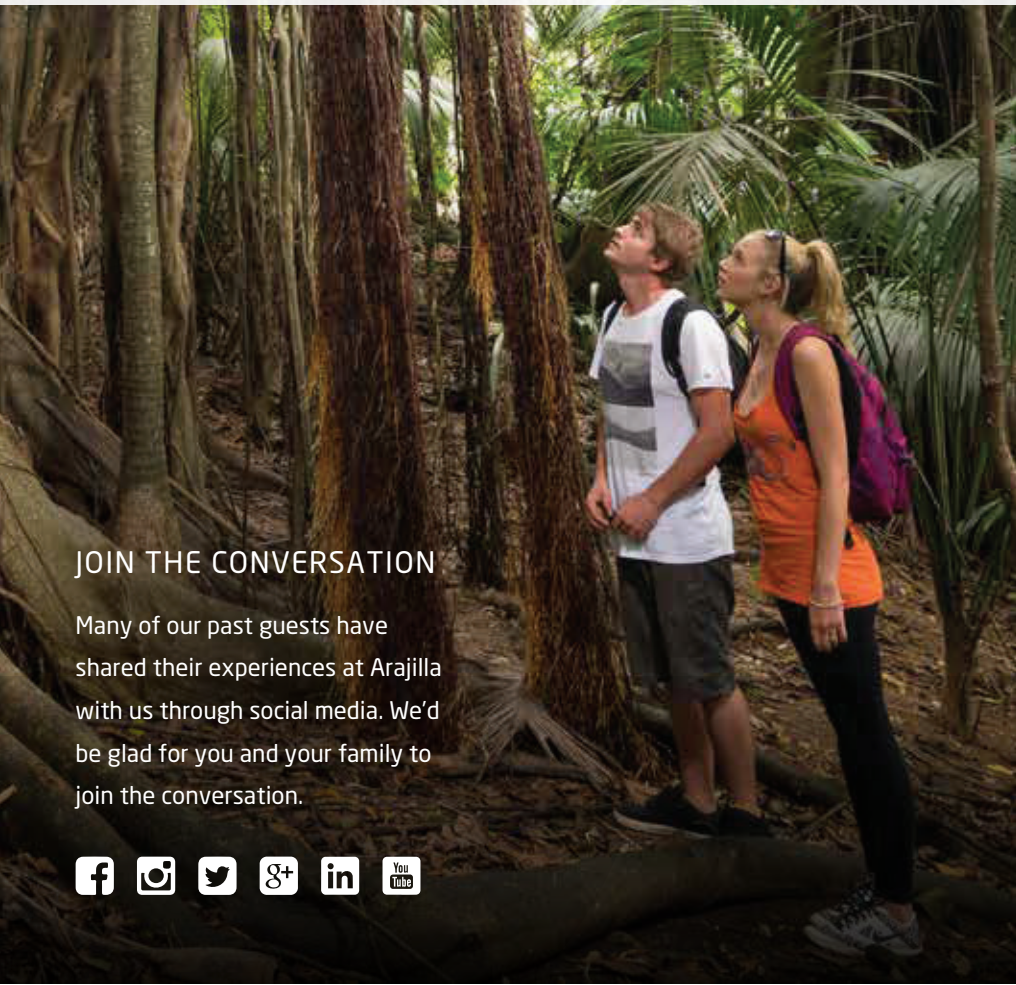

ARAJILLA & THE SHEAD FAMILY

In 1987 there was no regular air service, no regular shipping and nobody much had ever heard of the place.

Bill, Janne and their three girls had been living on the North Shore of Sydney, sailing to Lord Howe island every year for quite a while.

Bill was working in real estate with his father Newell, Janne had started up a catering business and the three girls were going to school and doing what girls do.

Out of the blue, on a Saturday morning in 1987 an advertisement for a property on Lord Howe island grabbed Bill's attention.



Within a week Bill & Janne were on a plane and soon the property was secured.

Properties on the island rarely come up for sale and this was a beauty, on Old Settlement Beach on the northern shores of the island's lagoon in a forest of Kentia Palms and Banyan Trees. The only problem was the terrible buildings; the newly arrived family had to live in a partly demolished house jammed up against a partly built house, or what was then intended to be a house.

Lord Howe then was indeed very remote, 400 nautical miles north east of Sydney in the Tasman Sea. In 1987 there was no regular air service, no regular shipping and nobody much had ever heard of the place.

Within 12 months the "house" was complete and the first ever cafe on the island was operating with the first espresso machine; staff accommodation was being built so more services could be offered.

Later a hydroponic system was set up to grow food. Water was collected from roof water and via desalination. A waste

water treatment system was set up that reticulated the treated water through the forest gardens.



The so-called "house" is now a dining room, office, laundry, staff accommodation, owners' residence and workshop all well planned to comply with the 15% site coverage stipulation.

Now after 29 years of hard work, with twelve Suites, a luxury beach house, and a dining room, Arajilla is the outstanding lodge on the Island.

BILL'S TOP 10

THINGS TO DO ON LORD HOWE ISLAND



1 **Climb to Kim's Lookout** For the best views over the island, you can't beat Kim's Lookout. At 200m altitude, it's not quite a walk in the park, but you'll be well rewarded for your efforts with views looking South over the whole island, the lagoon and out to Mount Gower. Just don't forget your camera!



Swim in the lagoon

There are few places on Earth that can claim such natural beauty as Lord Howe. A trip to the island would not be complete without a swim or snorkel at Sylphs Hole, on Old Settlement Beach, that's where the turtles come to swim.



Water Sports on the island

If you are looking for something a little more adventurous, the island offers perfect conditions for surfing, kitesurfing or windsurfing. Blinky Beach, Middle Beach, Ned's Beach or Little Island are great surfing places subject to the prevailing conditions. The Lagoon is the place to kitesurf, that is, if you have the gear, because it's not available here. Let us know when you arrive so we can check the local conditions to help you pick the best beach on the day.



Cycling and walking trails

Lord Howe island is very small, only 11km long and 2.8km wide. Guests to the island often prefer to explore on foot, and literally take in the natural beauty one step at a time. If riding a bike is more your thing, Arajilla has mountain bikes and helmets exclusively for your use.



World Class Scuba Diving

Lord Howe island is reputed to be amongst the best dive locations in the world. Whether you're a seasoned pro or someone who's never dived before local dive companies, Pro Dive or Howe Divers, will take good care of you. You'll be sure to love the experience so much you'll want to come back.



Take a leisurely walk

If you prefer a slower pace of life, there are endless walks on the island that guests to Arajilla enjoy. Be sure to take in the many interesting place names such as The Valley of Shadows, The Clear Place and Transit Hill along your way. If you're looking for a more adventurous walk be sure to organise a trip up Mt Gower with local tour guide Jack Shick.



A spot of fishing

I just love to fish here, in fact, I'd say it's my favourite thing to do here! Head out to sea for a chance to catch one of the 500 species of fish that inhabit the local waters. If you're lucky you might hook a Kingfish, Yellowfin Tuna or Wahoo. Guests are welcome to cook their catch using the barbecues provided, making it a perfect way to enjoy the island's fresh flavours at your own pace.



Stalk our feathered friends

Lord Howe island is a haven for bird-life and as such regularly attracts the world's top ornithologists. The island is home to 166 different species, including White Terns, Providence Petrels, Shearwaters and Blue Billies. When you arrive, let us share the story of a very special bird that is endemic to the island, thought extinct until recently.

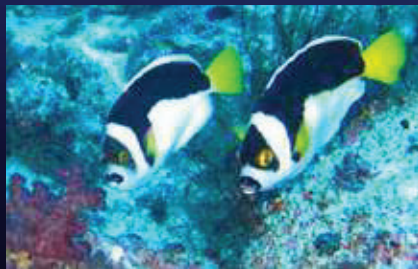
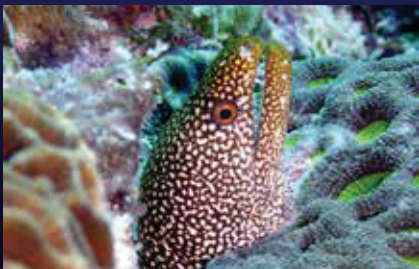


Switch off and get lost

The Admiralties are home to an abundance of soft corals, large schools of both temperate and tropical fish species, turtles, Galapagos whaler sharks and nudibranchs, to name a few. The world-famous Balls Pyramid is home to large black coral trees, underwater caves and it is believed to be the only place in the world where you can see the Ballina Angelfish on recreational SCUBA.

For those who have never tried SCUBA diving before we offer the PADI Discover Scuba Diving experience in which you can see what it is like to breathe underwater.

Our qualified PADI instructors will teach you some theory and skills before taking you on a guided dive in the sheltered waters of our beautiful lagoon, a truly memorable experience.
